The Renewable Centre Stadium

Our ground has a capacity of 1500 supporters, with spectator areas located on three sides of the pitch made up of two covered seated stands and one open standing terrace. Free car parking is available in Carreg Hir School 90 minutes before kick off and egress is needed within 60 minutes of full time.

Entrance

Access to the stadium is via the turnstiles located at the main entrance to the stadium, cash or card can be used on entry.

Accessibility

The club provides designated spaces for wheelchair users, with additional room for a carer if required. These spaces are available to book on a match-by-match basis, subject to availability. Check out our 'Access for All Guide below.

Away Fans

Away supporters are welcome to use all areas of the ground, the club does have a designated supporters area if needed for any games that require segregation situated at the North End of the Old Road Stand.

Macron Family Stand

Our Community Family Stand is located next to the open terrace on the right-hand side of the ground. This area is dedicated to season ticket holders and families, this area also hosts pre-match Junior Supporters' activities to keep our youngest Reds entertained before kick-off.

Bar Red – Clubhouse

Bar Red is the official clubhouse of Briton Ferry Llansawel Football Club. Open to both home and away fans, it offers a welcoming atmosphere, a selection of beverages, and multi-screens showing live sports. A great place to gather before or after the match!

Access For All



Access for All

Briton Ferry Llangawel AFC is committed to ensuring that all supporters, regardless of ability, enjoy a welcoming, safe, and inclusive matchday experience at the Renewable Centre Stadium. The following information outlines the facilities and support available to disabled supporters and those who may need additional assistance.

Wheelchair Users

We provide designated spaces for wheelchair users in the Old Road Stand. Each space includes an adjacent seat for a personal assistant or carer if required. For safety reasons, we strongly recommend that wheelchair users are accompanied by a carer or companion who is capable of providing assistance in the event of an emergency. This person should ideally be at least 16 years of age and in good physical and mental health.

Supporters with Visual Impairments

Briton Ferry Llangawel AFC is actively working towards providing audio-commentary services for visually impaired supporters. Guide Dogs are welcome at the Old Road Ground.

We encourage supporters attending with a Guide Dog to contact the club in advance to discuss:

- Access routes
- Facilities inside the ground

Welfare arrangements for the Guide Dog before, during, and after the match. We also recommend that visually impaired supporters are accompanied by someone who can provide support in the event of an emergency.

Supporters with Ambulatory Disabilities

We recognise that some supporters may use a wheelchair for outdoor mobility or have significant difficulty walking, without using a wheelchair full-time. These supporters, referred to as ambulant disabled supporters, may request seating close to entrances and exits. Allocation of these seats may require:

Proof of disability, or A case-by-case assessment via information provided to the Ticket Office or our Disability Liaison Officer. This ensures we can meet individual needs as effectively as possible.
